

# The Congressional Award

## Gold Medal Alumni Association

### Committees

**Objective:** To manage the programs and mission of the Alumni Association as directed by the Executive Board.

**Members:** Committee Chairman are appointed by the Program Director and approved by the Executive Board. Committee Chairman may select and recruit committee members without reservation.

**Committees:** All committees report to Program Director (VP). Nine committees carry out the objectives of the Alumni Association by recruiting volunteers (past alumnus) to aid in each task.

**Social:** Prepare Social Events for Alumni at National and Regional Levels.

**Volunteer:** Secure volunteer opportunities with the Congressional Award Foundation. Schedule alumni to speak at local ceremonies and create alumni mentorship program for current participants working toward their Gold Medal.

**Communications:** Prepare Avenues for alumni Communication (Facebook, Myspace, Website development, etc.)

**Scholarship:** Lead Fundraising effort to create a Scholarship Endowment Fund. Head Committee to review Association Scholarships for Entering Undergraduate Freshman and then later other education levels including Graduate School.

**Gold Medal Ceremony:** In charge of Gold T-Shirts, Certificates, and aid in other alumni events during the Gold Medal Ceremony.

**Recruitment:** Find and develop ways to recruit past and future alumni into the program. Keep records of "Where they are now."

**Youth Organization Development:** Work with CAF Partnering Organizations and promote award to local Youth Organization across the Country.

**School Relations:** Work to promote school relations at Universities and High Schools.

**Congressional District Office Relations:** Aid Congressional Offices in Administering the Award program to their Youth. Organize Manpower across the country.
